 - Discussed sense of belonging goal agreement that there is more support needed for Junior Coaches
 - Input Rules for the Sandia parking lot could be more clear

 - More of a challenge during pick up, than drop off
 - Clarified what happens if an ICS lead is absent during an emergency
 - Cross training has occurred, so a member of the team not assigned as a lead can step into the role.
